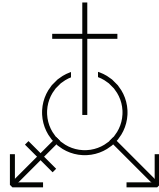


Transgender Christian:

Day 1: The Basics – 2 hours

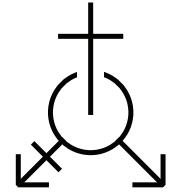
